

One-to-One Technology

We are extremely excited about our One-to-One Student Technology Program. Marmion has undergone significant technology infrastructure changes over the past few years. Our faculty members continually train on discipline-specific eLearning tools and student iPad classroom management.

All students are issued an iPad that is required for classroom use and educational purposes. In addition, but not as a replacement to Marmion issued iPads, students are allowed to bring their own computers. However, the final decision to use them in class is left to each instructor. For example, some engineering courses require running simulations while tutorials are read on the iPad. This type of computer use may not apply to reading an eBook/iBook, etc. and so, the final decision belongs to the instructor. Therefore, all students will be required to have an iPad as their eLearning resource for class.

Students will incur an annual technology fee of \$500, a total cost that is the summation of several items:



- Marmion infrastructure and IT Service and Support
- Printing capabilities through our Print Management Program
- School year lease of an iPad, charger and case
- Access to self service/educational apps
- AppleCare warranty plan

Students will have the ability to utilize eBooks on their iPads, which may offer a substantial savings over traditional textbook costs while providing individualized learning opportunities.
