#### Breakfast Stout

nose topped with a frothy, cinnamon-colored head that goes forever. (8.3% ABV)




### **Oktoberfest Lager**

#### O-Katz (Oachkatzlschwoaf) Oktoberfest Lager

by Urban Chestnut Brewing Company This "export" style lager, brewed for our annual Oktoberfest celebration, is malty yet well balanced like the bier traditionally served at Oktoberfest in

Munich. Howeverm our Festbier has a tale/tail of its own-Oachkatzlschwoaf (pronounced "oh-khut-zel-schvoaf") translated is "tail of a squirrel" ... just a little Bavarian humor. (5.4% ABV)



#### Oktoberfest

#### by Goose Island

Brewed in the traditional Märzen style, our Oktoberfest pours a brilliant copper over rose color with a bone white head. Notes of toffee and burnt sugar in the aroma and flavors

of sweet dried apricots are delivered in a dry malty body with the mild earthy bitterness that is the hallmark of Hallertau hops. (5.7% ABV) (5% ABV, GF)
